Claire will bring the large coffee pot for tea.

***Geshe Jamyang will make signs to be posted at the registration table indicating the price for members and non members. No one will be turned away for not paying the full amount. ***Dick will set up the dharma store.

*** Carol will be providing lunch for Damala and the board members. Lunch for other participants will be on their own.

Saturday – breakfast and lunch. There will be a fast from Saturday after lunch until Sunday morning breakfast


Sunday – breakfast and lunch.
